Any player registering with Westend FC accepts this Code of Conduct.

A Westend player must:

Never behave in a manner likely to bring the name of the club into disrepute.

Accept the referee's decisions at all times without protest by word or action and thank the match official after the final whistle.

Appreciate and respect their team manager and all other management team members.

Know and abide by the Laws, rules, and spirit of the game.

Attend all training sessions on time - and adhere to the Westend FC No train – No play policy.

Encourage and guide other team members to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and actions.

Always promote the positive aspects of the sport and consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance.

Not use or tolerate inappropriate language.

Shake hands with players from the opposing team at the end of the match, regardless of the result or any actions that may have taken place during the game.

Respect the rights of others regardless of age, gender, disability, culture, language, racial origin, religious beliefs, or sexual identity.

Treat all Club equipment/facilities provided with care, value and respect.

Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.
