



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WESTEND FC MANAGEMENT TEAM

Obligations towards the game

The management team member should

Set a positive example for others to follow, particularly young players and supporters.

Promote and develop the club having regard to the interest of the players, supporters, and reputation of Westend and the national game.

Share knowledge and experience when invited to do so, considering the interest of the body that has requested this, rather than for personal reasons.

Avoid all forms of gamesmanship, and not use or tolerate inappropriate language.

Show due respect to match officials and others involved in the game.

Obligations towards each age group

The management team member should

Make every effort to develop the sporting, technical and tactical levels of the club, and to obtain the best results for the club, using all permitted means.

Give priority to the interests of the club over individual interests and promote ethical principles.

Resist all illegal or unsporting influences, including banned substances and techniques.

Respect the interests of players, coaches and officials of their own club and others.

Obligations towards the supporters

The management team member should

Show due respect for the interests of supporters.

Respect towards the match officials

The management team member should

Avoid words or actions, which may mislead a match official.

Show due respect to match officials and accept decisions of the match official without protest.
